Over 250 pupils and staff took part in our first ever Fitness Friday workout. Pupils and staff worked together with the help of @thebodycoach.

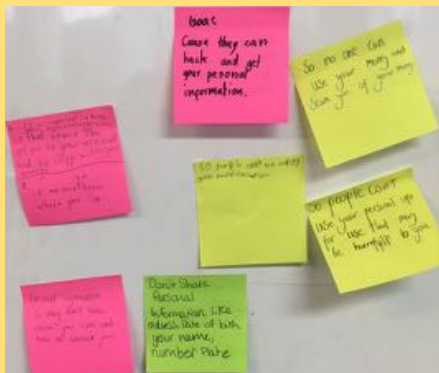
